



Dear UC Berkeley parents and guardians,

Together, as the Associate Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs / Dean of Students, Director and Associate Director of the LEAD Center, we are so pleased that the student in your family is a member of our bear community.

The UC Berkeley community is committed to making your student's experience at UC Berkeley as safe and engaging as possible. We encourage our students to be active and social in the UC Berkeley community, and to take advantage of all the opportunities available at Cal.

Every year, students choose to be active in fraternities and sororities, many of which offer fantastic and enriching experiences, social networking and ways to give back to the community. At UC Berkeley, 69 registered fraternity and sorority groups are active on campus, with approximately one in eight undergraduate students participating in these groups. These organizations are recognized for their commitment to following university guidelines, and frequently work in collaboration with the university on safety and wellness initiatives.

Unfortunately, we also have unrecognized groups active near our campus. These groups, not currently recognized by the university, do not take advantage of important trainings and advisement, nor are their events registered – which provides accountability in following policies and safety regulations. Despite no longer being recognized by UC Berkeley, several of these groups continue to operate and recruit students. Many of these groups potentially put students at risk and in unsafe situations by hosting parties and other social events that do not align with campus policies, practices, and standards.

We want your student to have a safe and responsible UC Berkeley experience, and stress that these unrecognized groups have not met the safety standards of the university. We encourage students to get involved with the diverse recognized groups in good standing with UC Berkeley. (lead.berkeley.edu/find-a-chapter/)

Recognized fraternities and sororities have proactively partnered with the university and are working to make student safety a priority.
